FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- Does the parent have to be present for the doctor's appointment? Parents are welcome to attend, but it is not required. Parents will always be notified prior to scheduling an appointment. A visit summary will be sent home with your child. Upon request, more detailed visit notes can be obtained from Family Medicine of Cloverdale at 765-795-4242.
- What if the doctor orders labs for a student?
 If labs are ordered, parents will have to take the child to Family Medicine of Cloverdale or PCH to complete tests. Strep, flu, and urine analysis test can be performed at the school clinic with parent consent.
- What if the doctor prescribes medicine for a student? The medication will be e-scribed to the pharmacy of parent's choice and pickup and payment will be the responsibility of parent.

- Will a student still be seen by the school nurse if they are not enrolled in the school-based health clinic? Yes. Students will be seen by the school nurse. However, no student will be seen by a physician unless the enrollment packet is completed and on file.
- If I enroll my child in this program will it replace their current doctor? No. The physician will treat your child's acute symptoms, and their primary doctor will continue to manage any ongoing issues. However, if you wish to switch to one of our physicians we are always taking new patients.
